

## Minmahaw School October Narrative Report 2015-16

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### Trimming Grass in front of the School (October 2<sup>nd</sup>) Friday

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> of October after school, the boys from both Minmahaw School and Minmahaw Higher Education Program cooperated to trim the grass in front of the school. They did the trimming to make a small football field where they can play in their free time. Even though it was tiring, the Minmahaw students had fun working together with MHEP boys.



### Backpack (October 9<sup>th</sup>) Friday

On 9<sup>th</sup> of October, Minmahaw School added a new subject. It is a health class taught by Mae Tao Clinic Backpackers. The class focuses on teaching First Aid Treatment by doing practical exercises with the medical accessories. All the students enjoy learning the First Aid treatments and doing practical exercises. On the first week, the teachers introduced the meaning of first aid and backpacking. On second week, the teachers taught how to do CPR (Cardiopulmonary resuscitation) process. Finally, the students practiced doing CPR with the medical dolls.



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### **Community Cleaning (October 17<sup>th</sup> )**

On 17th of October Saturday, there was community cleaning activity by Minmahaw School. Both Minmahaw School and Minmahaw Higher Education Program came together as one to do the cleaning. The students trimmed grass and cleared the ditches near the school. This is the fifth time doing community service by school in 2015-2016 academic year. Although it was exhausting, all students were happy and satisfied seeing the work done.



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### **Kites Flying (20<sup>th</sup> of October)**

On 20th of October, the students made the kites and flew them in craft class. At first, they made the bamboo sticks thin and smooth so that it is safe to use the sticks.
