- Supervised night study is held each night, Sunday till Thursday, from 7.00pm till 9.30 pm.
- All students must speak only English during the school day, and during Night Study.

# Minmahaw School

- Minmahaw School was established in 2009 under the Minmahaw Education Foundation, recently renamed Education for Friendship Foundation, and is based in Mae Sot, Thailand, on the Thai-Myanmar border.
- Minmahaw School is a boarding school operating independently with volunteer teachers and management.
- Applicants must have completed compulsory education, and must demonstrate an outstanding commitment to studies and leadership.
- Application are accepted from all religious and ethnic backgrounds.
- The School teaches three interrelated program:
  1. Vocational Studies, which for 2016/17 is Teacher Education
  2. General Post-Secondary Education
  3. Applied English, to develop Students' conversational and written English to enhance workplace opportunities.
- Academic Year classes commence on Monday 6 June, 2016.



- All teaching reflects an international Best Practice style—contemporary, experiential education - to develop students' critical thinking skills, English fluency, self-confidence and well-rounded personalities.
- The Academic Year Program accepts a maximum of 50 students and is comprised of 3 terms of approximately 3 months each.
- The School fee is 300THB per month (not compulsory for disadvantaged students).
- All students will live in the school dormitories, and all meals are provided.
- Students are expected to abide by the rules of Minmahaw School at all times.
- All students who complete the program will receive a Certificate of Completion.

## Academic Year Program Selection Process

- Students are admitted to the Secondary/Post Ten Academic Year Program through an Entrance Exam will be held on Friday 13th May, 2016.



- Applicants must have turned 17, and be no older than 23, by 1 June 2016.
- Application forms must be delivered by email or in person to Minmahaw School office by 12.00 noon Wednesday 11, May. (email [contact@minmahawschool.org](mailto:contact@minmahawschool.org))
- Registrations for the Entrance Exam at Minmahaw School will commence at 8.00am on 13th May, 2016.

## The Entrance Exam

- The 3 exam sections are Writing, Reading (Comprehension) and English Usage.
  - An English interview during the afternoon of 13th May, and
  - A Burmese interview on Saturday 14th May (for applicants living outside the Mae Sot region) or Sunday 15th or Monday 16th May (for students based in the Mae Sot area).
- The final selection of students will be published at Minmahaw School at 1.30pm, Tuesday 17 May.
